


# What is a genetically modified organism?



A genetically modified organism (GMO) is an animal, plant, or microbe whose DNA has been altered using genetic engineering techniques.



# Why would you modify a potato?

#### Resist pests and disease

Fewer potatoes are lost to pests and disease during the growing process creating a higher yield - also need less pesticides and fungicides

#### Reduce browning and bruising

Reduce browning and bruising that can occur during packaging, transportation, and storage

#### Produce less acrylamide


Acrylamide is a chemical with a potential link to cancer when exposed to high heat

# How are potatoes genetically modified?

### Silencing the GBSSI gene

First: amylose-free potatoes were produced by silencing the GBSSI gene using RNAi

Now: CRISPR/Cas9 is used to knock out the GBSSI gene



## **Negative Features**

- No hard packaging fragile foods (chips)
- Thin plastic can tear easily
- Plain potato bag has a tie on it instead of sealed - allows for easy theft

Would not propose any changes

#### **Positive Features**

- Bright colored packaging
- Picture of the finished product or it spruced up - makes it look very appealing
- Size/amount of food in the package
  - Examples: 2LBS or 8LBS



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
